Have you done anything really interesting this year? Have you been involved in a new project that others would like to hear about? Or have you been doing something for a long time that others could learn from? If so, come and share your expertise with us at the IMI Conference at the Old Swan Hotel, Harrogate 4th - 6th October 2018.

This invitation, open to members and non-members of the Institute, calls for abstracts for both the workshop and general presentation sessions. Workshops should be interactive and include audience participation where possible – giving delegates the opportunity for some hands-on experience! We also welcome abstracts for the New Voices session (short ten-minute presentations by first-time speakers).

Suggested themes include:

- New and novel uses of technology applied to photography, video and design in healthcare and healthcare education
- Ophthalmic imaging
- Graphics in Medicine
- Medical Art

This list is not exhaustive; we also welcome presentations based on traditional photography, art, design and video within the healthcare setting.

What we need

If you are interested in taking part, submit an abstract (see below). This should include a concise (200 words) description of your talk, detailing the project, issue or technique, and the lessons or ideas you would like the audience to learn from the session.

We would also like a brief biography; who you are, where you work, and your role and background in the field (50 words) along with a portrait headshot (jpeg, 300 dpi).
